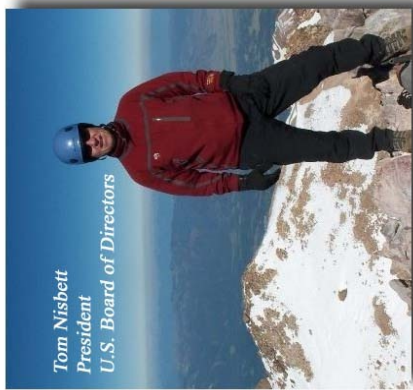

2nd Annual "CLIMB FOR SIGHT"

*A Benefit Climb for
Lighthouse For Christ Eye Centre
in Mombasa, Kenya*

In 2009, the first annual "Climb For Sight" benefit climb was a four-day trek and climb of 17,000 foot Mt. Kenya. The most significant part of this climb, in addition to Board Chairman Tom Nisbett reaching the summit, was the establishment of this annual event.



The 2nd annual "Climb For Sight" event will be a six-day trek and climb of Mt. Kilimanjaro

in Tanzania. Kili is 19,340 feet (5895m) and is the highest mountain on the African continent. Kilimanjaro is an immense island of alpine rock and ice, surrounded by the dry plains of Africa. It is the tallest free-standing mountain in the world and has



been an alluring destination for adventurers for more than a century. The "snows of Kilimanjaro" are world renowned and yet the glaciers may be

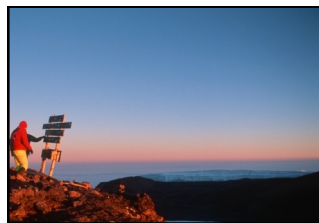
gone in another ten years.



all around the world.

While this climb passes through five climactic zones and ascends over 13,000 vertical feet (highest vertical gain of any climb), it is a non-technical climb. The climb itself usually takes 6-7 days

As one of the Seven Summits, it remains a strong draw for climbers and trekkers from



utilizing five camps established by the Tanzanian National Park Service. Porters, cooks, and local guides accompany the group, enriching the experience and offering their extensive expertise on the mountain.



How Can You Help?

Climb Cost: \$1,500* plus airfare of approx \$1,600 (expedia price flying KLM)

Trip Dates: Sept. 23-30, 2010

Funding Example: Tom Nisbett (a climber) is planning to climb Mt. Kilimanjaro in Tanzania. The ideal charity is one like the Lighthouse for Christ Eye Centre in Mombasa. Donors pledge an amount for each of the mountain's 19,340 feet. The breakdown looks like this:

\$1 per foot = \$19,340
 \$.10 per foot = \$1,934
 \$.50 per foot = \$9,670
 \$.05 per foot = \$967
 \$.25 per foot = \$4,835
 \$.01 per foot = \$193

Let's say that the charity's donors pledge a total of \$50,000. The climber's expenses of \$5000 are paid out and the charity keeps \$45,000. The charity's only other cost is the cost of the mailing to its donors which it does two or three times per year anyway.
